Supplemental and Summary Information on SAR - POKER 22/P-4/CB3 (C)

SUMMARY (USE SEPARATE SHEET OF BOND PAPER IF ADDITIONAL SPACE IS REQUIRED)

- (C) Rescue efforts were suspended at 1856H on 6 Dec due to darkness. Six rescue attempts had been made during the day with all helicopters taking hits.
- (C) A first light SAR effort was initiated on 7 December as planned. Initial voice contact was established with BRAVO at 0724Z. BRAVO advised SANDY lead he had moved north and strangers now occupied his former location. Exact location was confirmed by aprobe. No contact has been made with ALPHA since evening of 5 Dec. The area was suppressed and a rescue attempt was made at 0940H by JOLLY GREEN 77/HP-58/UDN. The effort was unsuccessful due to visibility. At 1252H JOLLY GREEN 77 made a successful rescue of BRAVO who was reported to be in good condition. The survivor was taken to NKP.
- (C) An electronics search for ALPHA is still in progress.
